Dear Parent / Carer,

Yesterday, we were delighted to have received a letter, personally signed by the Rt. Hon Damian Hinds MP – Minister for Schools. The letter was to congratulate St Peter's for its outstanding work in teaching phonics, which put us in the top 3% of the country. He congratulated the staff and pupils' for this superb achievement. However, I would like to go further and thank the parents who ensure they listen to their children read regularly, attend our parent workshops, and invest in the processes and systems we have in place. St Peter's is also in the top 8% of all schools nationally for progress in reading when they leave school at the end of Year 6.

Last week, we started a term long rugby development programme with St Helen's Rugby League Football Club. Coaches will be coming in to take a PE session with some classes for half a term, giving the pupils specialised training. The classes involved have given very positive feedback so far and we look forward to continuing this relationship with 'The Saints' in the future.

On Thursday, our Parent Forum met. We had very positive discussions about all things St Peter's, focussing on our Rainbow Team, school academic performance, and provision for personal development. I would like to thank those who attended. Your interest, thoughts and ideas about St Peter's are really valuable and help us to drive our school forward. As part of our commitment to make maths exciting and high profile in our school, we are taking part in a friendly competition involving schools in the United Kingdom for NSPCC Number Day.

The competition runs from **07:30 to 19:30 GMT on Friday 2nd February**. It's all done online via play.**ttrockstars**.com. Years 3 to 6 will take part.

Children can play in any game mode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours, subject to a 60-minute limit (see below)).

Winning classes in the school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.

To support player well-being, there is a daily time limit of 60 minutes per player. Once the player goes beyond 60 minutes of play on that day, they will still earn coins but will no longer earn points towards the competition.

In the spirit of the competition, please don't play on their behalf but by all means, encourage and support them to the extent that it doesn't cause high stress levels or impact on family plans.

Holiday Requests

Please note that all term time holiday requests will be unauthorised. Taking holidays during term time does have a detrimental effect on a child's education. Extended holidays in particular can be the difference between children achieving their year group objectives and not particularly if the pupil then is off for period of time with a sickness. Any pupil that falls below 94% attendance is classed as a cause for concern and will be contacted by the Education welfare Officer.

There are penalties, as set out by St Helens MBC, that could lead to up to £600 for a family of four <u>Penalty notices - St Helens Borough Council</u>

If your child wishes to change their lunch preference please advise the office via email giving <u>a week's notice</u>. Payment is taken through the School Money Online Payment System.

ABSENCE

When reporting on the absence line, can we politely request that you leave a brief description of your child's illness rather than just saying they are unwell. If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

Applications for Holiday Leave must be submitted to school at **least 4 weeks** in advance. Forms can be found on the school website or requested from the school office. In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.

CHANGES

It is very important that if you change contact numbers, emails or addresses that you advise us as soon as possible. Any changes must be sent into school via email.
