IMPORTANT -FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Due to significant changes to free school meal eligibility following the roll out of Universal Credit we are encouraging parents to apply for free school meals. Even if your child is currently getting a free school meal because they are in infants it is important to register. **Any child that is eligible for a free school meal before the 1st April 2018 will have that eligibility protected until the end of the roll out of Universal Credit (March 2020) or the end of their educational phase.** Therefore any children in Y3 today and eligible for a free school meal will continue until the end of Secondary School.


For your child to qualify for free school meals, you must get one of the following benefits:

- Income-Based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income Support
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit

The following benefits and assistance also apply for qualifying for free school meals

- The guarantee part of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit as long as you are not getting Working Tax Credit and have an annual income of less than £16190.
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- In England and Wales, if you are getting Working Tax Credit for a run on period of four weeks because you have stopped work or reduced your hours to less than 16 hours a week, or in some cases, less than 24 or 30 hours a week, you may still be able to get free school meals for your children.
