I am learning to ... write my letters correctly

Can we ...?

- ✚ Go outside and practise writing these letters correctly



*** Remember I need to start at the right place for each letter.
Please see letter formation chart.

We can use



water and a paint brush



chunky chalks



mud and stick

- ✚ Play a game

First we will need to write each letter on a piece of paper

Game rules

- We turn the pieces of paper face down so we can't see the letters
- Take turns to turn over a piece of paper, saying the letter name
- Write the letter correctly in water, chalk, mud or on paper
- Each get a point if we write the letter correctly
- The person with the most points at the end is the winner

To help me to get better at my writing, I could

- Spell some words using the letters e.g. *dog, cat, tag, coat, goat ..*
- Write a sentence using one of my words

Top tips to help me learn ...

- ⇒ Show me how to write each letter correctly, one at a time
- ⇒ Let me practise writing each letter lots of times – writing big letters then small letters
- ⇒ **Celebrate my learning**, tell me what you like and why
