Message from St Peter's

Dear Parent / carer,

This week I received an email about our Early Years Quality Mark Inspection we had a few weeks ago. I am delighted to inform you that St Peter's has now achieved the Early Year Quality Mark, which is a national accreditation for our Early Years Foundation Stage provision. You will find the report on the website and makes great reading. This award is in addition to our recent Basic Skills Quality Award, Music Mark, Primary Science Quality Mark, National Online Safety Accreditation, UNICEF Rights Respecting and a new Youth Sports Trust Accreditation.

As many of you will know the school was significantly underperforming when I arrived three years ago, with results at the end of Key Stage 2 consistently below the national average. With the introduction of a new and rigorous inspection framework, achieving the grading of nine years ago will be extraordinarily difficult to say the least. However, please be reassured that, the staff, the children and whole school community are working together to continually raise standards in all aspects of our school and the plethora of awards and quality marks shows how much progress has been made. School Parent surveys and Pupil Voice surveys are overwhelmingly positive, and you can find these on our website along with everything else that happens in school.

Unfortunately, the local authority has told us that face-to-face meetings with parents are still not on the agenda and so for the moment, we will continue with Microsoft Teams and phone calls for parents evening. Details will follow next week, where you will be able to choose your preferences for dates, times and method of meeting. Hopefully, one day this will all be over!

Last week, I issued for Key Stage 2 the St Peter's Award Scheme. The children seemed engaged, and we hope that by the end of the year, I am handing over many Bronze, Silver and Gold Certificates. On Monday I delivered a Key Stage 2 assembly about relationships online, what constitutes online bullying, how group chat conversations can get out of hand, and what to do if you don't know the person who is trying to talk to you. The children's self-awareness was very pleasing to hear and I will continue to drive home the message about how to enjoy the use of mobile and online appliances and be safe.
