

Message from St Peter's

This week we have been concentrating on the act of remembrance. If you follow our Facebook site, you will see plenty of pictures that show what we have been teaching and also what, who and why we remember. Our focus this year was on the Great War. As you know, Norman Harvey VC went to this school and was awarded the highest military award for storming machine gun nests that fired 600 bullets a minute, not once but twice. He captured over 20 prisoners and saved many lives. Norman is in our curriculum and this year we talked about life in WW1 in our remembrance service and the sacrifice. Thirty-four ex pupils and a teacher died fighting in the war and remembered them by saying each of their names out loud. We have also had our bronze memorial plaque reconditioned by a family who have now left us. Thank you to Mr Parfrey and we will have more on this in due course.

The kitchen staff put on a lovely display of remembrance with special cakes and decorations and our waterfall of poppies that made it into the St Helens Star, is back up for all to see at the front of the building.

Today we have had a photographer come into school. First, he completed a whole school assembly about WW1 and then worked with Year 2 dressing them up in costumes. The pictures, which were taken by some of our Year 6 children under instruction, will be used to produce a hardback book with the images made to look like they were really taken in 1914. They had a great time and it was lovely to hear our children talk in detail about what they had learned in history lesson.

On Sunday, the school will be laying two wreaths, one in St Peter's church and one at the Cenotaph in Earlestown. We will be accompanied by our head and deputy girls and boys.

Covid – 19: I have been made aware of a very sharp rise in St Helens of positive Covid -19 cases and it is not showing any sign of declining. The symptoms seem slightly different and we have sent an email out this week informing you that any children with a stomach upset should have a lateral flow test.
