Contact

Can we please ask that if you change your address, contact details or emails you need to advise school as soon as possible.

Also if there are any changes to your child's medical needs you must contact the school office and complete the relevant forms.

Testing

With positive cases still high in our local area we are doing everything we can to ensure that our school continues to stay open with healthy children and staff, With this in mind can we ask again that you support us in the testing of your child on a regular basis.

- Testing on a Lateral Flow Device should be undertaken twice a week.
- Positive Lateral Flow Tests must be reported to Test and Trace and school as soon as possible, you then need to self-isolate and follow the relevant guidance. You do not need to book a confirmatory PCR test.
- If a close contact of your child is positive they must have a lateral flow test done every the morning before they attend school for the day until that close contact tests negative.
- If you or your child shows any symptoms you still need to book a PCR test and you must isolate until the results of the test come through.

If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

Applications for Holiday Leave must be submitted to school at **least 4 weeks** in advance. Forms can be found on the school website or requested from the school office. In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in <u>exceptional</u> circumstances.

Changes

It is very important that if you change contact numbers, emails or addresses that you advise us as soon as possible. Any changes must be sent into school via email.
