ANSWERS

Monday 4.5.20

$$2.8 + 0.6 = 3.4$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 2.8 \\ +0.6 \\ \hline 3.4 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

1

$$4 \times 3 \times 9 =$$

$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

$$12 \times 9 = 108$$

$$40,000 - 900 = 39,100$$

e.g. count on from 900 to 40,000 on a number line or work it out in a column

$$3/8 \text{ of } 48 =$$

$$1/8 \text{ of } 48 \text{ is } 48 \div 8 = 6$$

$$\text{so } 3/8 \text{ is } 3 \times 6 = 18$$
