## What are the features of a newspaper report?

- Headline (alliteration, catchy)
- Introduction paragraph (who, what, where, when, why)
- Detailed paragraph
- Speech & interviews
- Conclusion (what's going to happen next).

## Headlines

Headlines need to be catchy to grab the readers attention.

 You can also use alliteration. Alliteration is when two or more words starting with the same sound are next to each other.

Here are some examples.

'Armstrong Arrived!'
'Man on Moon'
