# What are the features of a newspaper report?

- Headline (alliteration, catchy)
- Introduction paragraph (who, what, where, when, why)
- Detailed paragraph
- Speech & interviews
- Conclusion (what's going to happen next).

# Headlines

- Headlines need to be catchy to grab the readers attention.
- You can also use alliteration. Alliteration is when two or more words starting with the same sound are next to each other.
- Here are some examples.
- 'Armstrong Arrived!'      'Man on Moon'
