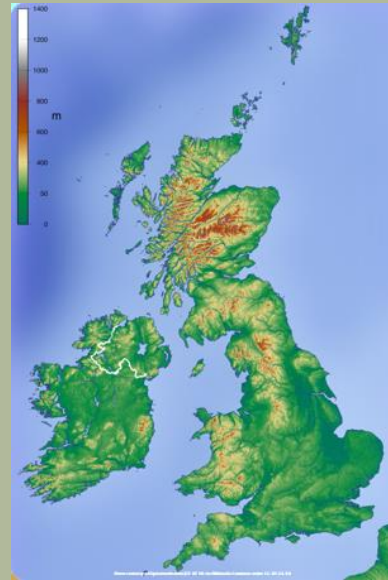


This week, we're going to explore the mountains of the U.K. and look at how contour lines are used to show areas of higher ground on maps.
