Dear Parent / Carer,

After an extended weekend, we quickly got back into the everyday busy life of school. On Wednesday, we were delighted to host some of the parents of our new Reception children for a little coffee morning. Thank you for coming and I hope you enjoyed yourselves. On Thursday, Years 4 and 5 went to the Clonter Opera Theatre in Congleton. They had a great time and really expanded their cultural thinking and experiences.

At the time of writing, I was just about to take a team of Year 6 girls to a football tournament in St Helens. I have signed St Peter's up for a lot of sports tournaments this half term and this will continue throughout the year. With sport and exercise always on our agenda in school, we have now enrolled a sports coach who comes in every lunchtime to take a class of pupils for activities on the artificial pitch area. The infants take part in the first half of the lunch break and then as they go in for lunch, Key stage 2 get their turn on a rota basis. LENDING LIBRARY



The lending library is located on the playground for KS1 and KS2 section. Books are free to parents on a take a book/leave a book system.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Could your child be entitled to receive Free School Meals?

Your child will be eligible for free school meals if you (or your partner) are in receipt of any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (but not Working Tax Credit) and your annual gross income (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) is not more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit and net earnings, from your last assessment period, is not more than £7,500 per year (£616.67 per month).

Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

Once eligible, your child will continue to receive free school meals in primary or secondary school until they finished their current phase of education i.e. primary (Year 6) or secondary (Year 11).

The school receives additional funding if your child is entitled to FSM which enables to support your child with other areas of school, i.e. intervention groups and educational visits. If your child is in KS1 it is still important you apply to access other support. A claim form is also available in the school office.

From 1 April 2023, if your child moves between primary and secondary school you need to reapply for free school meals.



Holiday Requests

Please note that all term time holiday requests will be unauthorised. Taking holidays during term time does have a detrimental effect on a child's education. Extended holidays in particular can be the difference between children achieving their year group objectives and not particularly if the pupil then is off for period of time with a sickness. Any pupil that falls below 94% attendance is classed as a cause for concern and will be contacted by the Education welfare Officer.

There are penalties, as set out by St Helens MBC, that could lead to up to £600 for a family of four Penalty notices - St Helens Borough Council

If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

Applications for Holiday Leave must be submitted to school at **least 4 week**s in advance. Forms can be found on the school website or requested from the school office. In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.
