Dear Parent / Carer

We welcome everyone back after a well earned, if not wet, half term break. The coming half term promises to be packed as we enter the festive season. We look forward to nativities, pantomimes, Christmas dinner, carol concerts, movie nights and let's not forget breakfast with Santa.

Next week we start with a joint antibullying and inter faith week, looking into tolerance and respect. Our inter faith week looks as exciting as ever, as we welcome visitors from local Muslim, Hindu, Jewish and Buddhist communities.

We also start off our Anti Bullying Week by wearing odd socks on Monday. Our pupils are hugely knowledgeable about what bullying is and isn't and when I talk to them in assembly about bullying, either in school, out of school or online, they are all aware of what to do. 
Congratulations to Zoe in Year 4 who has received her new Blue Peter reading badge. This has been added to her collection which includes a music and environmental badge.

Holiday Requests

Please note that all term time holiday requests will be unauthorised. Taking holidays during term time does have a detrimental effect on a child's education. Extended holidays in particular can be the difference between children achieving their year group objectives and not particularly if the pupil then is off for period of time with a sickness. Any pupil that falls below 94% attendance is classed as a cause for concern and will be contacted by the Education welfare Officer.

ABSENCE

When reporting on the absence line, can we politely request that you leave a brief description of your child's illness rather than just saying they are unwell. If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

Applications for Holiday Leave must be submitted to school at **least 4 week**s in advance. Forms can be found on the school website or requested from the school office. In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.
