On Thursday, Year 6 visited Tatton Hall as part of their history work. It was a great experience and enjoyed by all.

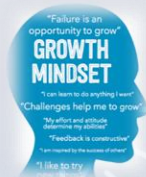

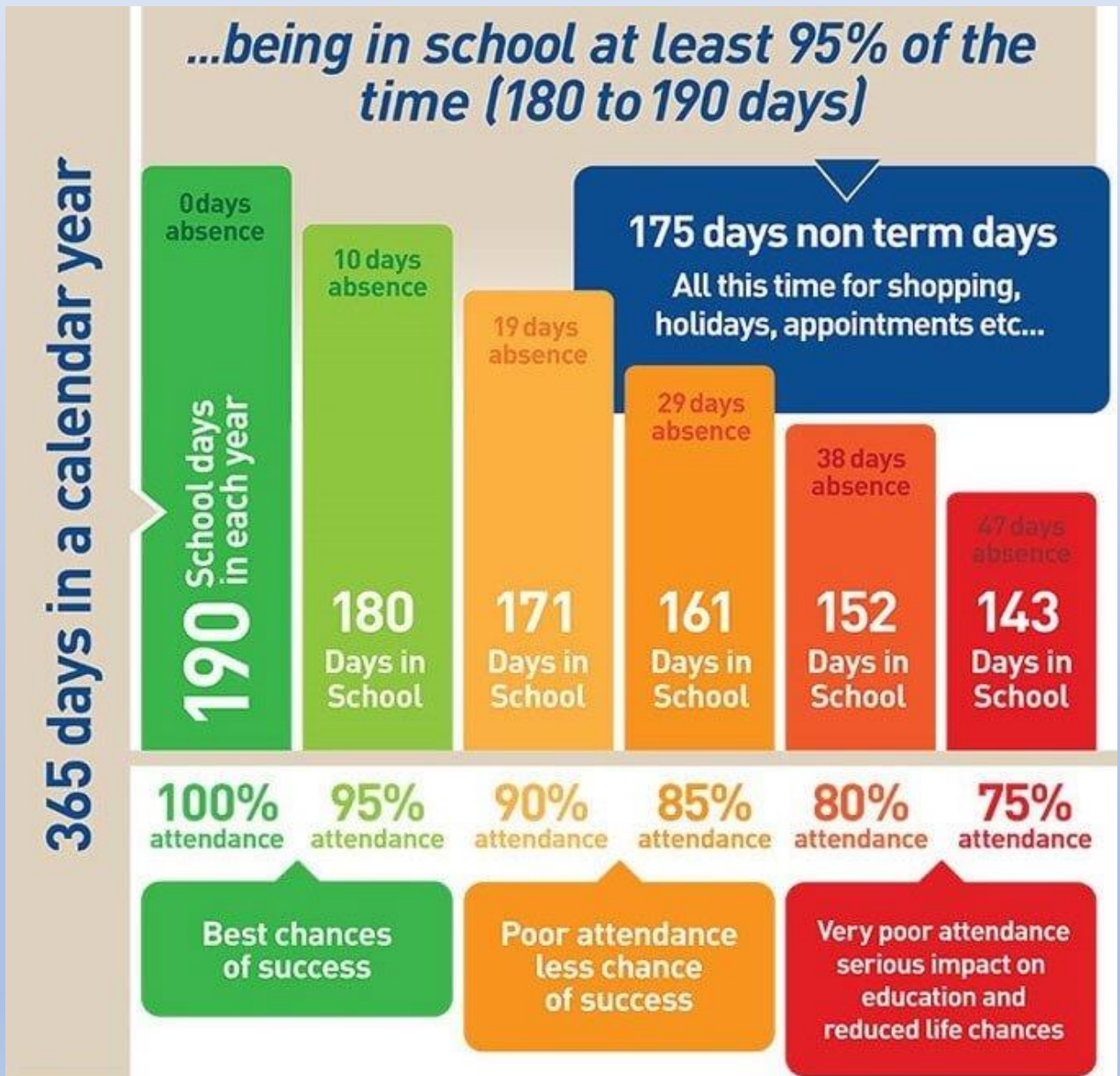
Attendance

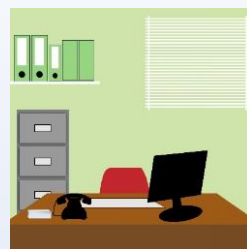

ABSENCE

If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.
