MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD TEACHER

Dear Parent / Carer,

A big thank you to the PTA for putting on a truly amazing fun day on Saturday. The sun was shining upon as the day took on, as one person said, a festival atmosphere. Thank you to everyone who attended, it was a fantastic event which raised thousands for the school. We have an approximate figure; however we will reveal that as soon as we know.

On Monday, Year 5 visited Hope Academy for their annual Ethos Day. Attended by a lot of local schools, this is a great way of adding to the transition between primary and high school. The staff are always very welcoming, and the pupils gain a lot from it.

On Wednesday, we held our first SEND coffee morning. It was a fantastic turnout, much more than we expected, and I hope those that attended were able to take something away from it. We had a talk from ADDvanced Solutions, who are an excellent community network who offer programmes and learning opportunities that raise awareness; develop skills; share learning experiences; and build confidence; supporting the families of neurodiverse children & young people, who may also have specific learning difficulties or associated mental health needs. We also had a talk from Neurodevelopmental Pathway (giving details on Autism assessment or to discuss assessment for children currently on the pathway) and the school nurse who gave information on what they do. Parents were then able to have meetings with the various agencies and Mrs Vinyard. We hope to make these a regular occurrence going forward.

St Peter's host the Newton Schools Football Tournament each year for Year 6. Created by our school, we invite all local schools for a boys and a girls event. This year was a great success, with all the schools attending. As we run the tournament, we obviously couldn't win, that would be unsporting, so both teams decided they would come fourth. Well done to both teams!




Our Early Help approach

ABSENCE

When reporting on the absence line, can we politely request that you leave a brief description of your child's illness rather than just saying they are unwell. If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.
