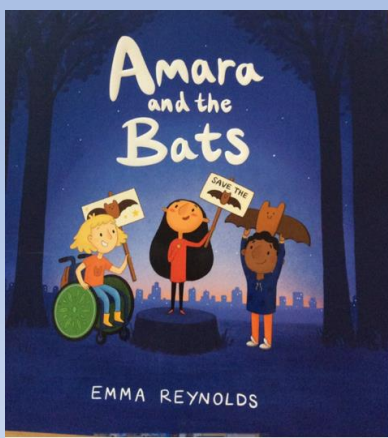

Recently the Reception class really enjoyed their occupational visit from Jude's dad, who works as an Ecologist. He shared with us how he looks after bats and has to go around houses to check if there are any protected species before any building work commences. He talked about what was meant by protected species and the children named a few. He showed the children all the different type of equipment he uses, including a hi vis jacket, a hard helmet, an endoscope, and bat detectors, and demonstrated how this worked. We learned lots of bat facts, including how they are nocturnal and how they can fly in the dark, using echolocation. We talked about different species and what types of food they eat. They even got to have a look at a real life bat, a Pippistrell.



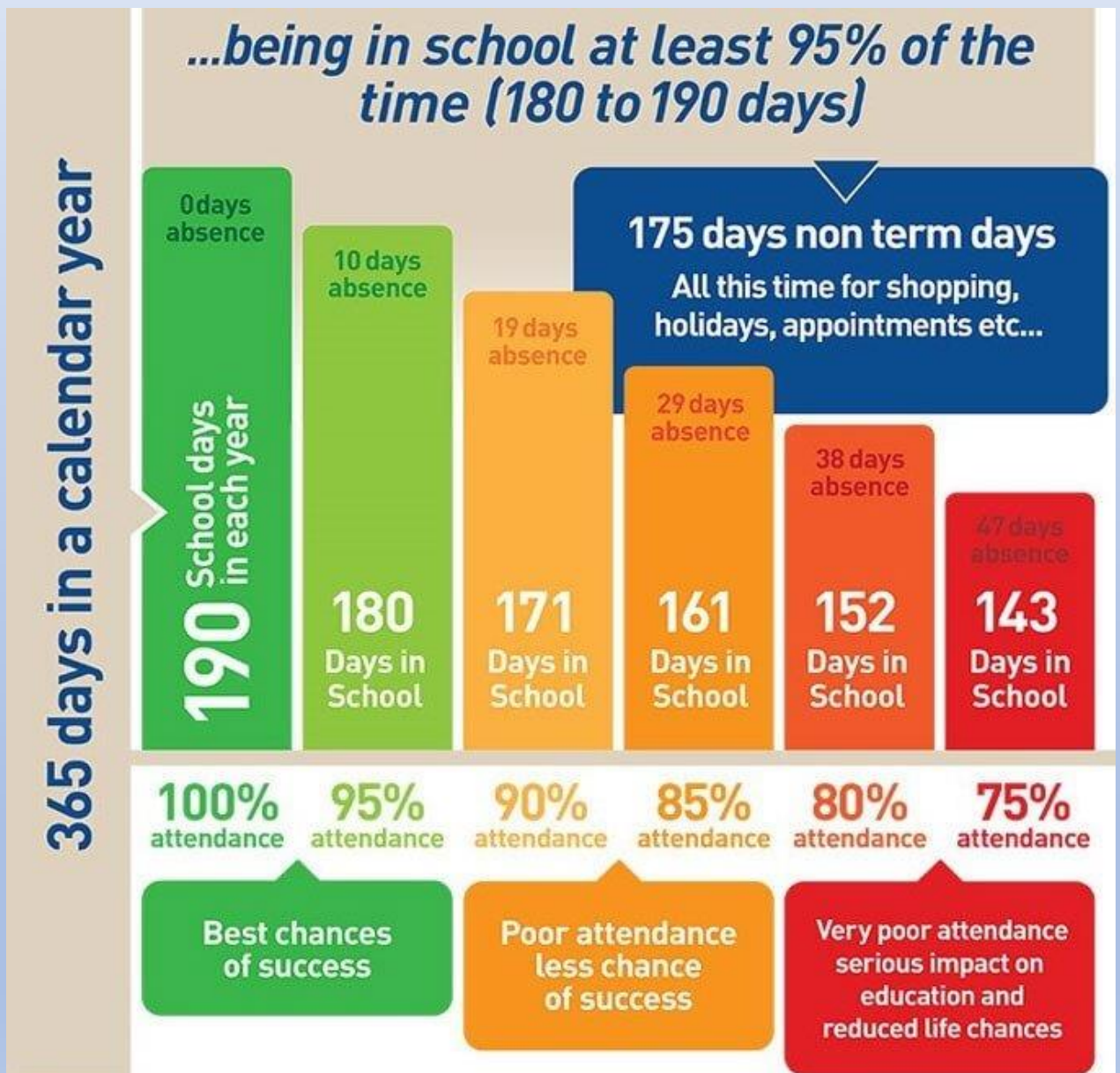
Attendance

possible outcomes.

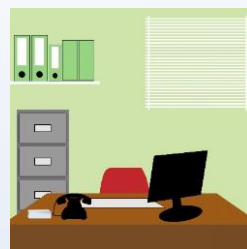
Our Aims

ABSENCE

When reporting on the absence line, can we politely request that you leave a brief description of your child's illness rather than just saying they are unwell. If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.
