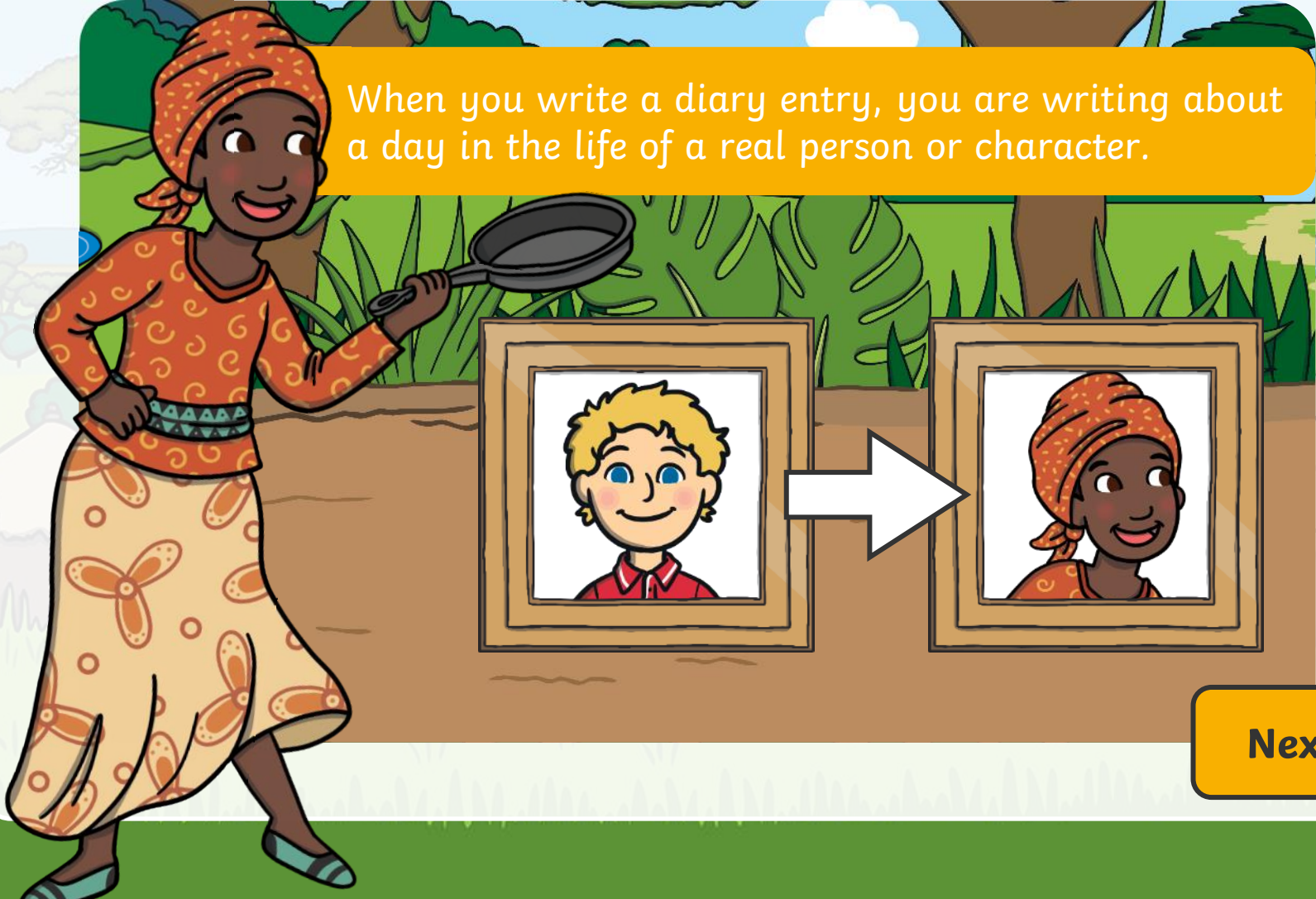

These words are special because they tell us the diary is being written **by** someone and they are talking about **themselves**.

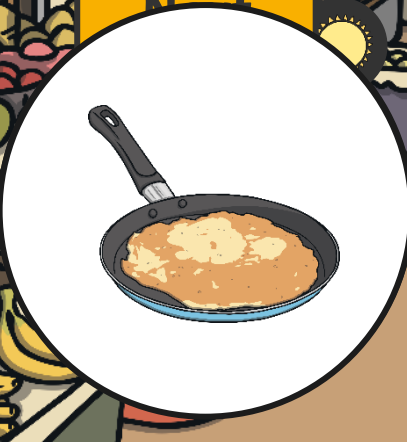

What could happen if you put the events in the wrong order?

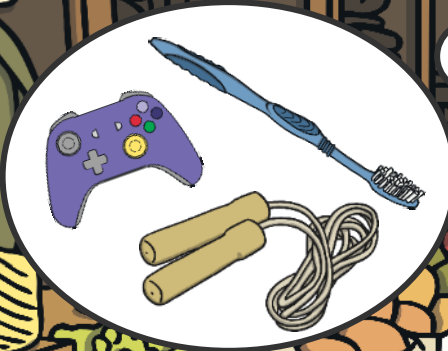

Using Time Linking Words

To make sure that events are in the correct order, it is helpful to include time linking words. You might want to use 'first', 'next' and 'then'.

Example Answers

First, I bought some flour for the pancakes.

Then, I saw my best friend Thema at her fruit stand.

Next, I ran over to the spice stand to pick out a chilli.

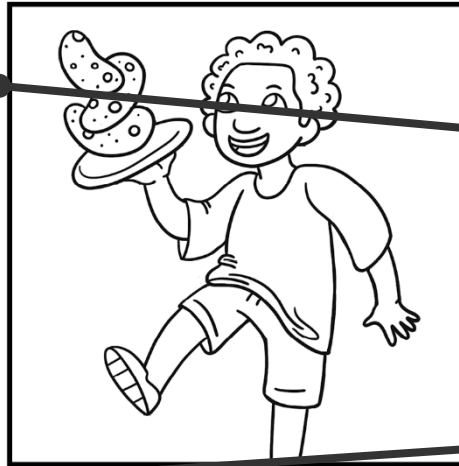

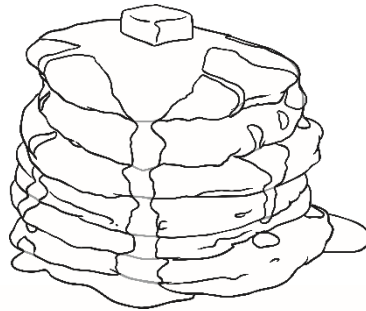
